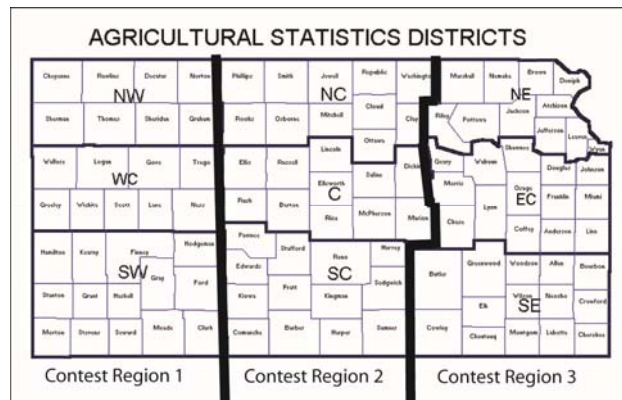


# KANSAS WHEAT

## *2012 Wheat Yield Contest Harvest Rules and Harvest Entry Form*

1. This contest is open to any wheat grower in Kansas. Members of the Kansas Association of Wheat Growers may enter for free; non-members must pay \$50 per entry (to defray the cost of hiring a Third Party Verifier).

Entries will be separated into Western, Central and Eastern regions (see map below).



2. An entry shall consist of one (1) field of at least five (5) acres in size.
3. F.S.A measurements will serve to verify the size of an entry field. If yield check is limited to five (5) acres, measurements will be taken by the County Extension Agricultural Agent, or his or her representative.
4. Contestants are required to complete three forms: Entry Form, Management Form and Harvest Form. These are available on the Kansas Wheat Web site, and will be mailed to contestants. All contest records will become the property of the contest committee when yields are compiled. All decisions made by the contest committee will be final.
5. Each contestant is to notify the County Extension Office at least 2 days before harvest is expected, and the day of harvest.
6. Harvest operations are to be witnessed, and combine grain hopper is to be inspected and empty before harvest begins. Examples are: Service club representative, FFA instructor, or **any individual designated by the county agent.**

7. Weight of wheat from the field shall be verified by official elevator scale tickets. Nothing else will be accepted. A minimum of five (5) acres must be checked. Weight from the entire field may be taken, if desired.
8. Scale tickets must accompany official entries.
9. Moisture percentage and foreign matter must be recorded on the scale tickets.
10. Yield is to be adjusted to 13.0 percent moisture by using the following formula to obtain conversion factor:

$$\frac{100 - \text{Actual Moisture Content}}{100 - 13}$$

Multiply wheat weight by the conversion factor to convert to 13%. Weight per bushel is 60 pounds. Calculate yield to nearest .01 bushel.

11. Foreign matter in excess of one (1) percent must be deducted from yields.
12. Participants will be asked to collect a two-pound sample of harvested grain from the contest field, to be mailed to the Kansas Wheat office. This grain will be reviewed for several quality components. Owner of the single entry possessing the best overall quality score, as measured by Kansas State University, will receive \$250. *Sponsored by Louis Dreyfuss Commodities*
13. Contest records and entry fees must be postmarked by July 10, 2012. Entries postmarked after July 11, 2012 will not be accepted. The entry forms should be sent to:
