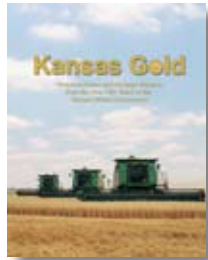




## Bake and Take

As the largest wheat-producing county in the state, the Sumner County Wheathearts wanted to share in the celebration of the harvest. This allowed members of the community to bake their favorite dish and share it with someone special. Even though the Kansas Wheathearts disbanded in 2001, Kansas Wheat continues these efforts today by partnering with the Wheat Foods Council in a national promotion of Bake and Take Month. 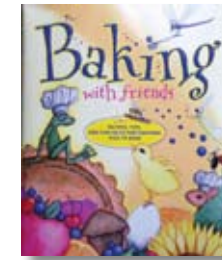


## When is Bake and Take?
