Counties without a County Fair Market Wheat Show:

All exhibits in the Market Wheat Show shall consist of 5 pounds of wheat grown by the exhibitor in the current year. All samples entered that have not gone through a County Fair Market Wheat Show and have not been graded by the Kansas Grain Inspection service must be submitted with an entry form to the Kansas State Fair by August 16. The 5-pound sample can be sent in any container. Please enclose an entry form with only Market Wheat on it, and no other crop entries. Please mark on outside of package "Market Wheat Show." These samples will be graded by the Kansas Grain Inspection Service and scored. All entries must be made by variety name. All entries must be combine run, as hand picking and/or screening is not allowed. Since all varieties in a class will be competing against each other a producer may enter a maximum of three different varieties per class per farm unit and be paid premiums. **The wheat exhibited will become the property of the Kansas State Fair.** These entries will be eligible for the Sweepstakes Award. This classification is separate from the 20 pound wheat exhibit.

Counties with a County Fair Market Wheat Show:

All exhibits in the Market Wheat Show shall consist of 5 pounds of wheat grown by the exhibitor in the current year and is to be turned in to their county extension office for entry in the local county market wheat show. All Market Wheat Show samples that were entered in a County Fair Market Wheat Show and graded by the Kansas Grain Inspection Service must be pre-entered online by August 16. "The local County Extension Agent should deliver the samples to a Market Wheat Show Committee member by August 27, 2010, or bring the samples to the Kansas State Fair on August 31 at 10:00 a.m." Entries must be made by variety name. All entries must be combine run, as handpicking and/or screening is not allowed. Since all varieties in a class will be competing against each other, a producer may enter a maximum of three different varieties per class per farm unit and be paid premiums. **The wheat exhibited will become the property of the Kansas State Fair.** These entries will be eligible for the Sweepstakes Award if the exhibitor participated in their local county market wheat show."

All entries submitted will be judged by the following criteria and graded by the Kansas Grain Inspection Service:

Statements for Official Crop Data Card regarding production of entry will include: Variety; Certified seed (yes or no); Continuous crop or summer fallow; Field's prior crop; Ground preparation (tillage tools used); Type of drill used; Approx. seeding date; Fertilized (yes or no, kind and amount); Herbicides (yes or no and kind); Harvest date; Approximate yield, bushels per acre; Acres of field; Type of combine used to harvest (Conventional or Rotary); Name and address. Entry and Crop Data Cards may be obtained from County Agents or the Kansas State Fair.

MARKET WHEAT SWEEPSTAKES

Entries to Sweepstakes classes must have participated in the local county Market Wheat Show if one was held. **Counties with a Market Wheat Show are asked to forward their county champion (1) name and (2) wheat variety to Andrea Burns, Kansas State Extension Agent of Ford County to: Ford Co. Gov't Center, 100 Gunsmoke, KS 67801-4456 Dodge City, or email to: aburns@ksu.edu by August 16, 2010.** If no show was available, county Sweepstakes entry will be the county entry with the highest scorecard. Stafford County Flour Mills will provide awards for the Market Wheat Sweepstakes Classes. Ribbons will be given to all participants plus a Champion Ribbon from each class. Placings will be determined by the Market Wheat scores. Entries from counties with no Market Wheat Show, must be pre-entered by August 16th, and must include the sample and entry form.

- 619 Eastern Kansas County Winners. Includes all counties with Highway 81 going through it and East.
- 620 Western Kansas County Winners. Includes counties west of Highway 81.
Champion Ribbon for winner in each class.

SOYBEAN SEED

The Soybean Seed classes are composed of major companies that service Kansas soybean producers and popular varieties. If a brand name or public variety runs strong in the "any other variety class" in a particular year, it will be placed in the Superintendent's Option. It will also be considered the next year to replace a variety that is decreasing in entries. Since all varieties in a class will be competing against each other, a producer may enter a maximum of three different varieties per class per farm unit and be paid premiums. An exhibit shall consist of 15 lbs of soybeans harvested in 2009 or 2010. Hand picked samples are encouraged.

CORN - 5 EARS

If a brand runs strong in the "any other class" in a particular year, it will be placed in a Superintendents Option class. It will also be considered next year to replace a variety that is decreasing in entries. Since all varieties in a class will be competing against each other, a producer may enter a maximum of five different varieties per class per farm unit. Exhibitors will be paid for top three premiums. Exhibitors must give the name and address of the dealer from whom the seed was purchased. In case of a shortage of space on the display racks, some non-ribbon entries may be removed after judging to make a better appearing display.
